PURPOSE

To provide a method for suppliers to identify damaged DMMI returnable packaging and send it back for repair.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Inspect returnable packaging and reject damaged totes.
 Damaged totes consist of any condition that may jeopardize product quality or safety at DMMI or the supplier.
 Examples:
 - Torn corners.
 - Cuts on sides over 4" long.
 - Missing handle inserts.
 - Missing corner reinforcements.
 - Severely creased material that may lower the packages stacking strength.
- B. Accumulate damaged packaging. It is acceptable to mix damaged packaging types on one pallet. The skid may not exceed 72" in height.
- C. Stretchwrap the pallet.
- D. Complete the Damaged Supplier Packaging Form (see FORMS section) and attach to the pallet on four sides.
- E. Return pallet to DMMI on a regular shipment.
